### Medallic Art Company Medals

The Medallic Art Company (MACo) was founded in 1903 by noted French sculptor Henry Weil, and enjoys the foremost reputation among private American mints for designing, engraving and striking beautiful, high-relief medals.

### **Monnaie de Paris (The Paris Mint)**
